



TUITION PAYMENT: \$87.55/month flat rate

A flat-rate tuition payment is due the last rehearsal of each month in advance for the next month. Payment secures a reserved band slot. Payment is not a per-rehearsal fee. No credits, discounts, or refunds accepted for any reason. All payments are automated via recurring billing (credit card, checking account, or your bank's bill pay service). Payments cover rehearsals with an instructor, Rock Academy staffing, and event management. Students play events for free; however some events may require a ticket prices for spectators. Your payment will be set up in-studio using our authorization form, or over the phone with Nate Richards - call 610-908-5668. Transactions occur on the 24th day of the month in advance of the next month.

LATE PAYMENT

Payments received on or after the 1st calendar day of the month are considered late. If payment is received on or after the 7th day of the month, a \$10.00 late fee will be charged. Consistent late payment or unpaid late fees may result in termination of services. Late payments may occur due to auto payment insufficient funds, card expired, or bill pay service error. SCHEDULE

Rehearsals once per week for 60-75 minutes. Periodic shows scheduled as they become available.

POLICIES

1. All RRA students must be current and on-going Richards Guitar Studio private students.
2. No makeups are possible for missed rehearsals. No credits, adjusted payments, or refunds. All payments are final.

3. Students are expected to practice at home and prepare their music to the best of their ability prior to rehearsal, as well as participate in any shows that become available, private or public.
4. Equipment: students should have the essential equipment for performing live on their instrument (amps, pedals, tuners, straps, keyboards, etc). Many venues have house equipment for use, and RGS staff and stage management generally supply guitar amps, bass, amps, keyboards, and drum equipment at shows. Drummers should be prepared to bring cymbals, snare, kick pedal, and throne, as many venues do not provide these items. Students generally only need to use their own large equipment items at outdoor festivals, if they conflict with other RRA band rehearsals.
5. Students are welcome to use the studio for song writing collaboration, or just hang out when space is available. We ask for appropriate behavior and noise level as lessons are in session. Call Nate to check availability if you plan to come in and work on songwriting with a bandmate.
6. Bullying, inappropriate behavior at shows or rock academy social media, destruction of studio or venue property, and similar offenses will not be tolerated. Student conduct of this nature will result in expulsion from the band program.
